

NORTHEAST PARK INVENTORIES ON THE WEB

As Northeast Region park inventories of wildlife and water and air quality are completed, the reports of these surveys are posted on the Web site for science in the parks in the Northeast (<http://www.nps.gov/nero/science>). Two recent postings are notable. One is *Data Review and Synthesis of Natural Resources Information from Cedar Creek and Belle Grove National Historical Park*, which reports on a new park in Virginia established in 2002. Another report of interest to natural resource managers dealing with disparate data being collected from many

taxon-specific surveys is *Biodiversity Inventory: Approaches, Analysis, and Synthesis*. This report reviews analytical and statistical tools used to integrate biodiversity data and provides recommendations for analyzing these data in a way that is useful for managers developing general management and resource management plans.
