


Activity - Volcanism Crossword Puzzle

Across

- These volcanoes are the largest volcanoes in the world.

- Steam, carbon dioxide, sulfur compounds and chlorine compounds make up this hazardous substance which is emitted from volcanic vents.
- These volcanic hazards can burn, crush, or bury anything in their path. They are slow moving, and rarely a threat to human life.
