General

1. Freshwater benthopelagic fish

Geography and Habitat

1. Native: Sacramento, San Joaquin, Pajaro, and Salinas river drainages in California
2. Introduced: Rivers of the west and southwest US, North and South Dakota, Nebraska
3. Habitat:
 - Originally occurs in vegetated sloughs, pools of sluggish rivers and lakes
 - Now most common in ponds and impoundments
