Creeping bentgrass

General

1. Creeping perennial graminoid

Geography and Habitat

1. Native: Eurasia, north Africa
2. Habitats
 - Woodlands, forest openings, grasslands, shrublands, prairies, sandhills, meadows, marshes, bogs, vernal pools, stream and lake margins, disturbed/ruderal areas
 - Common on recently exposed sand and gravel bars, wet meadows, riparian zones
 - Tolerant of salt marshes, drought, poorly drained and subirrigated conditions, submergence, flooding
 - Grows best on loam, clay-loam, and sandy soils, but occurs on gravelly and rocky substrata

Invasion Pathways

1. Imported turf vegetation and erosion control/revegetation
